3.1 (1209) BCS Policy Review

3.3 (310) FIBT Calendar

The 5b Calendar has been distributed and it shows two world cups, two America cups and an ICC in Calgary and Whistler. A meeting was held between FIBT, Lake Placid and Park City and because of the three competitions running back to back at the start of the year and then the ICC in Whistler, the same weekend as the AC in Calgary, Park city officials are willing to work, if required. Don has spoken with Don Krone, FIBT, about the costs associated with moving officials and the medical care required in Calgary. Further developments will be brought back to the next meeting.

4. General Operations Update.

4.1 CEO Report: 510 May 18, 2010

1. General:

- a. Two planning documents are being developed for the Association and OTP. Dr. Norris has been heavily involved in the 2020 Vision 2010-2020 Strategic Guideline planning document and Matt and Nathan are working on the OTP performance planning document for the next 4 years
- b. I am finalizing staff but the three biggest issues are still HC Bobsleigh, HC and S&S coach skeleton. On the skeleton side the candidates are identified but we are negotiating salaries.
- c. We have met with CSCC about IST personnel and funding. I have met with Dr. Lun our Chief Medical Officer who will be transitioning to Dr. Brian Benson
- d. Attended the Winsport session on May 3. The park is still not sustainable in that general revenues do not meet general expenses and that the endowed funds are still being used to close that gap. Increase fees, reduced expenses are narrowing the gap but not eliminating the short fall.
- e. Shaulyn is working on a proposal to the FIBT to allow us some leniency on ambulances during AC races, which would save significant dollars.
- f. The office has created and distributed the BCS Trust newsletter. They presently have an account of about \$400,000 and provided BCBSA with a loan to purchase training sleds.

2. Marketing and Sponsorship:

- a. We have had two agencies and 2 persons have expressed interest in the position and I will be sending out an RFP for their review and completion.

4.2 Finance

Dwayne presented the updated financials up to March 31, 2010. There is still no confirmation on funds forthcoming from OTP. Don presented a preliminary 2010-2011 budget, but there are still quite a few unknowns, but a final budget will be presented at the next meeting.

6.1 Conflict of Interest

The current Conflict of Interest policy does not address the issue of a Director applying for a paid position within BCS. Upon adoption of the proposed amendment, the Board of Directors Code of Conduct will be amended.

If a Director wishes to apply for a paid position with the Association, the Director must resign their position on the Board prior to submitting an official application. If the Director is unsuccessful in the job competition, the Director would not be able to let their name stand for reelection to the Board for one calendar year.
