A high-performance track and field athlete at the varsity and national level, Justin Kripps got introduced to the sport of bobsleigh after accepting an invitation to participate in a testing camp in August 2006. Justin quickly discovered the sport was a fun and unique challenge, which he was willing to take on and pursue a career in.



Since that time, Justin claims that other than the much colder competition conditions he's used to in track and field, his transition from the track to a sliding sport has been extremely smooth and successful. Justin was one of the top brakeman on the Canadian Bobsleigh Team for nearly three years. After competing in his first Olympic Winter Games in Vancouver-Whistler, Justin has now moved up into the driver's seat after taking pilot's school in the summer of 2010.

PARCOURS DANS LE SPORT :
